

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS EQUIPMENT

SPECIFICATIONS

Size: 20' or 40'

Type: Hoarding, gantry, breezeway, platform, walkway, staircase

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Before using the equipment

- Ensure that the equipment is the correct type for the intended use
- Ensure that you have been given a physical demonstration on the correct use of this equipment
- Keep hands and fingers away when placing or landing equipment on the ground or up against adjacent equipment or buildings to prevent crush injuries
- Use the correct lifting points for the type of equipment being elevated

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)



- Wear gloves, eye wear and non-slip footwear

Site Preparation and Setup

- Maintain a safe distance from delivery vehicles. Do not stand under a suspended load or between the moving equipment or adjacent objects
- Set the container down in an area safe from passing traffic and onto stable, level ground
- If the container floor level is more than 300mm above ground level, ensure a compliant step or landing is installed for safe access

Handling Removable Floor Panels

- Ensure safe removal of floor panels using the appropriate tools
- Floor panels are heavy. When handling, keep hands and fingers clear of edges and obstructions to prevent crush injuries

ELEVATED INSTALLATIONS

- Safe installation of elevated pedestrian access equipment requires supporting equipment to be positioned on compacted, level ground
- Stairs must be securely fixed to platforms
- Stair adaptor bracket must be fitted to the end of the platform prior to stairs being installed
- Ensure all twist locks have been engaged prior to installing and fixing stairs
- All cantilevered walkways must be secured before installing and fixing staircases
- Use the lifting points provided for staircase
- Use the correct type of plant for the equipment being elevated
- To eliminate working at heights, perimeter barriers and handrails should be installed on the platform at ground level prior to lifting
- For further assistance including detailed installation instructions and SWP/SWMS for elevated platforms, perimeter barriers, stairs and stair adaptors, please refer to your Royal Wolf representative
